

avoided certain places, events, or situations out of fear of antisemitism




avoided making themselves visually identifiable as a Jew out of fear of antisemitism



refrained from posting Jewish-related content online out of fear of antisemitism





# How much of a problem, if at all, do you think the below is for Jewish college students in the U.S. today?






# Compared to a year ago, is the status of Jews more secure, about the same, or less secure?






#### On which platforms have American Jews been targeted by antisemitism? \*Asked of American Jews targeted online





### AJC's survey of the U.S. general public: Familiarity with the term *antisemitism*






# Do you, personally, happen to know someone who is Jewish?






### of Americans have witnessed an antisemitic incident in person, online, or against a Jewish institution over the past 12 months


#### Over the past five years, do you think that antisemitism in the United States has...
